# New York State of Health

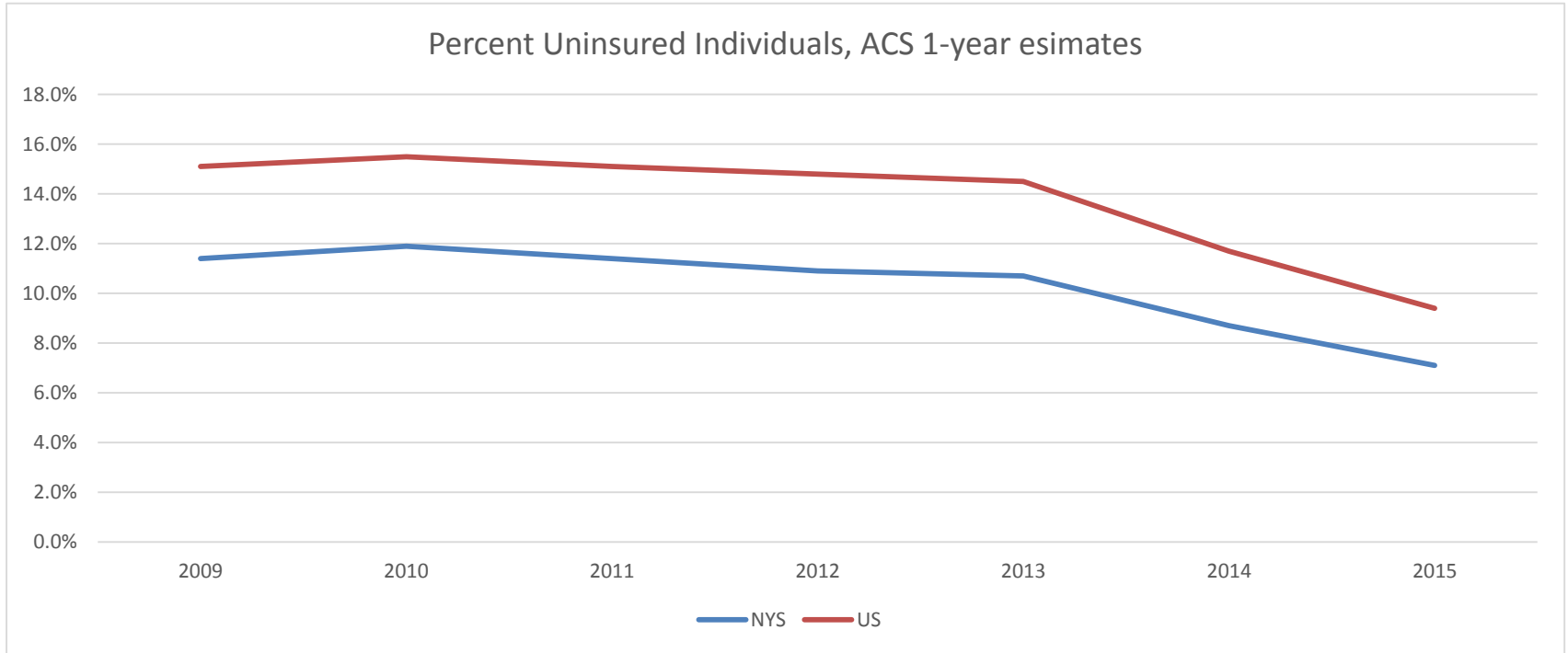
- Health insurance enrollment before ACA and NY State of Health

# New York State of Health

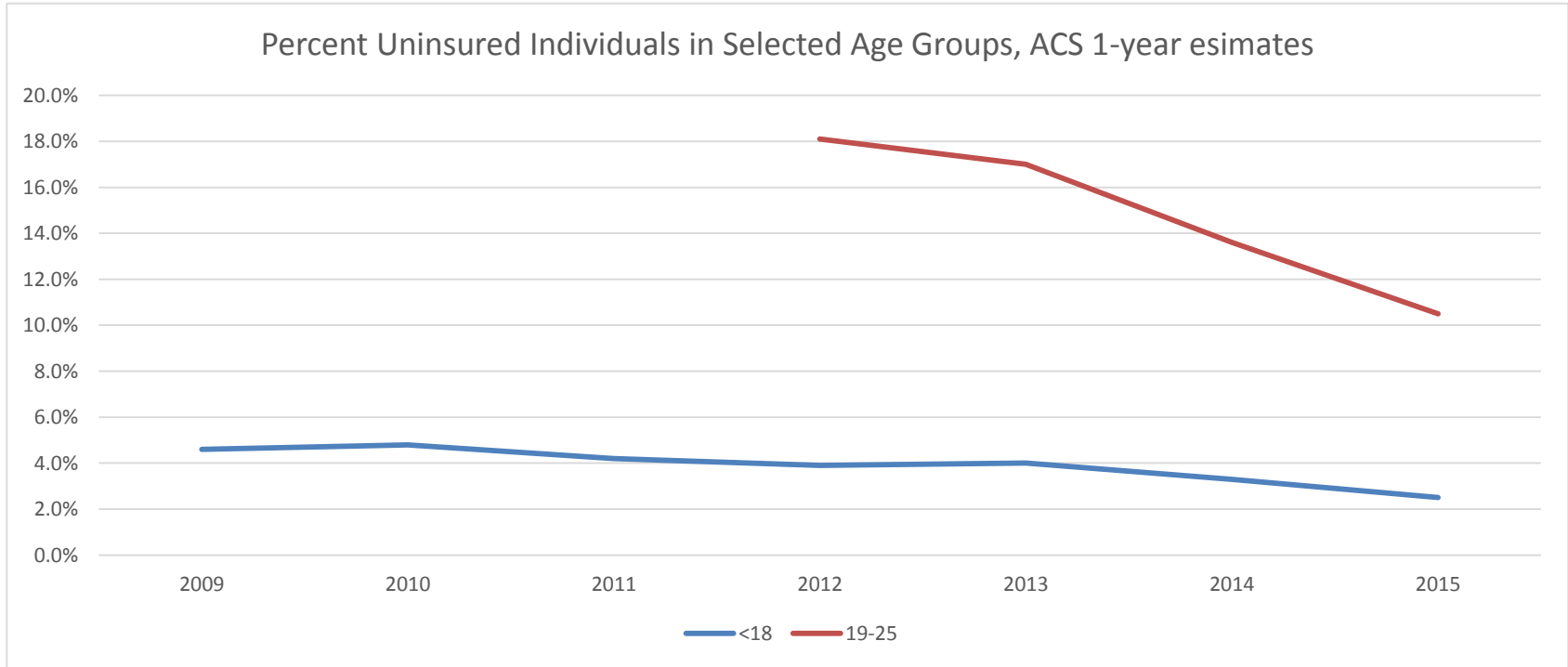
- Collaboration with NYSDOH Office of Health Insurance Programs (OHIP) and NYS Dept. of Financial Services

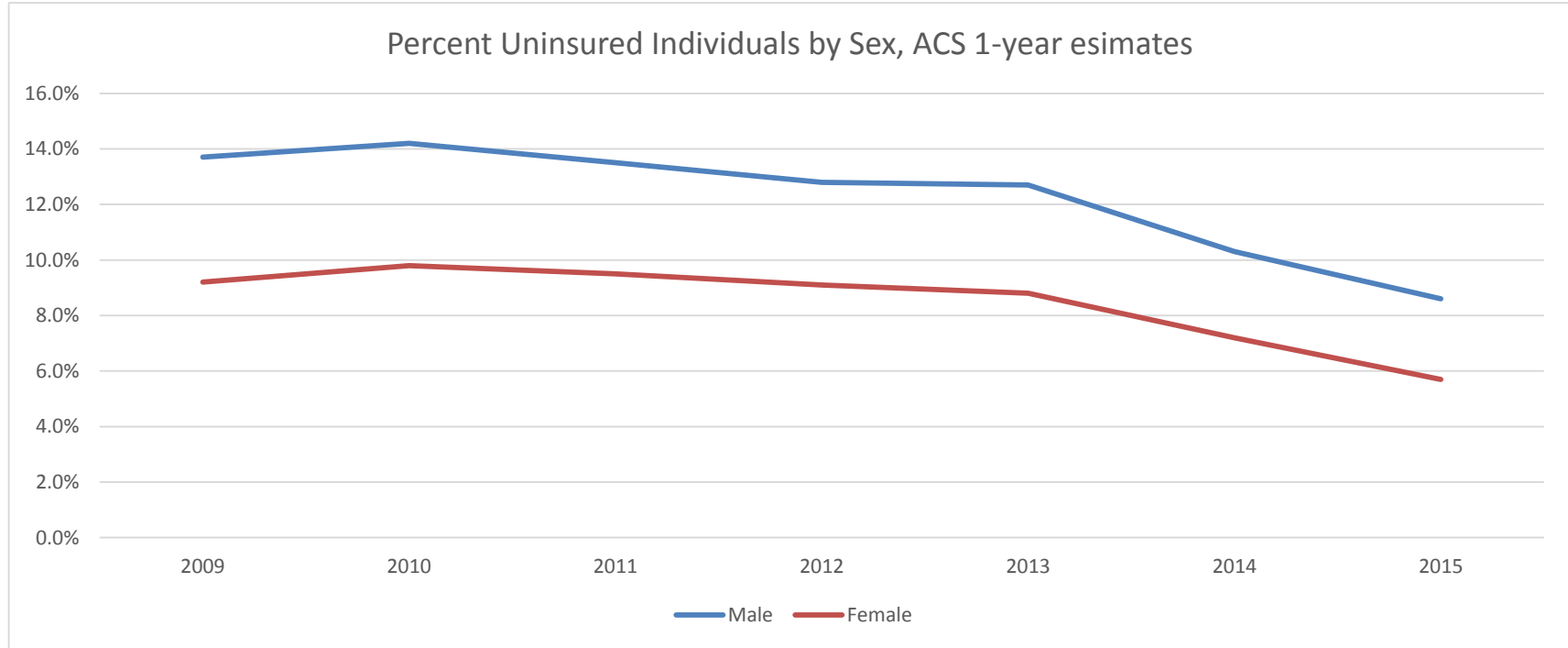

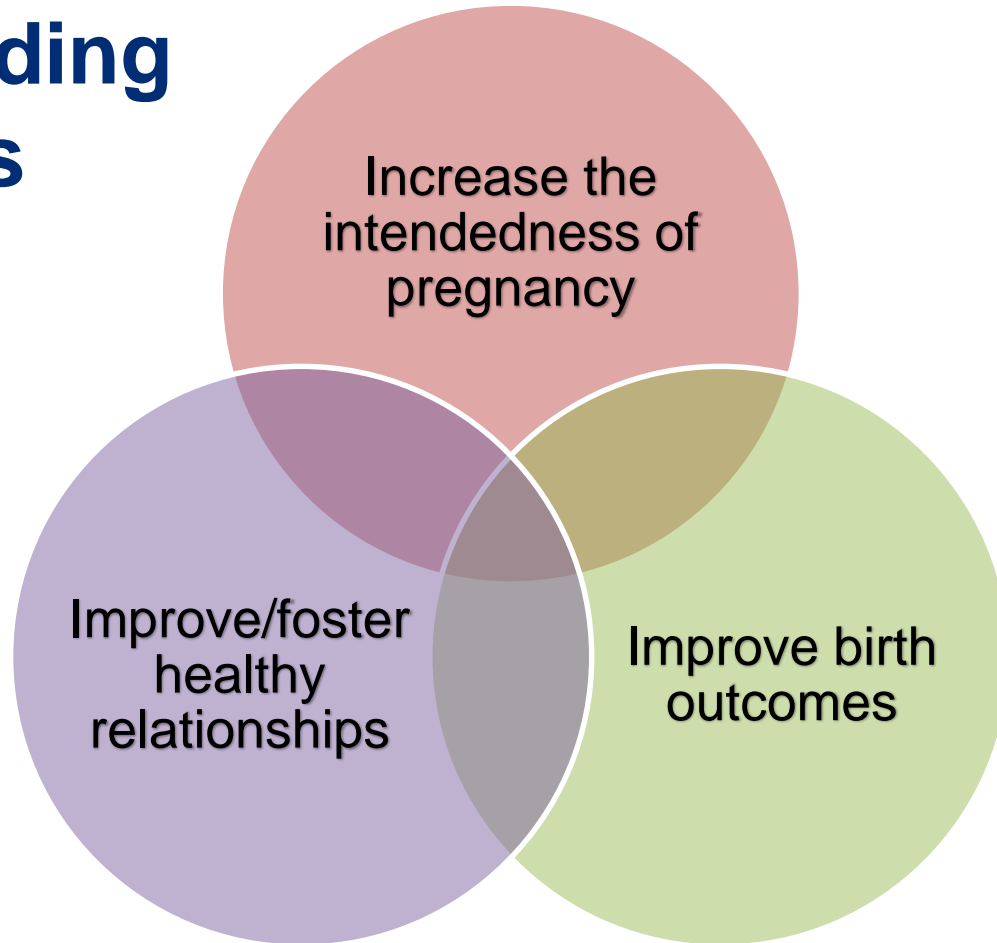

- Prevention Agenda:
  - Focus Area 3: Reproductive, Preconception & Inter-Conception Health
    - prevent unintended and adolescent pregnancy
    - utilization of preventive health care services of women of reproductive age
- Title V MCHSBG:
  - Reduce racial, ethnic, economic, and geographic disparities and promote health equity for MCH population

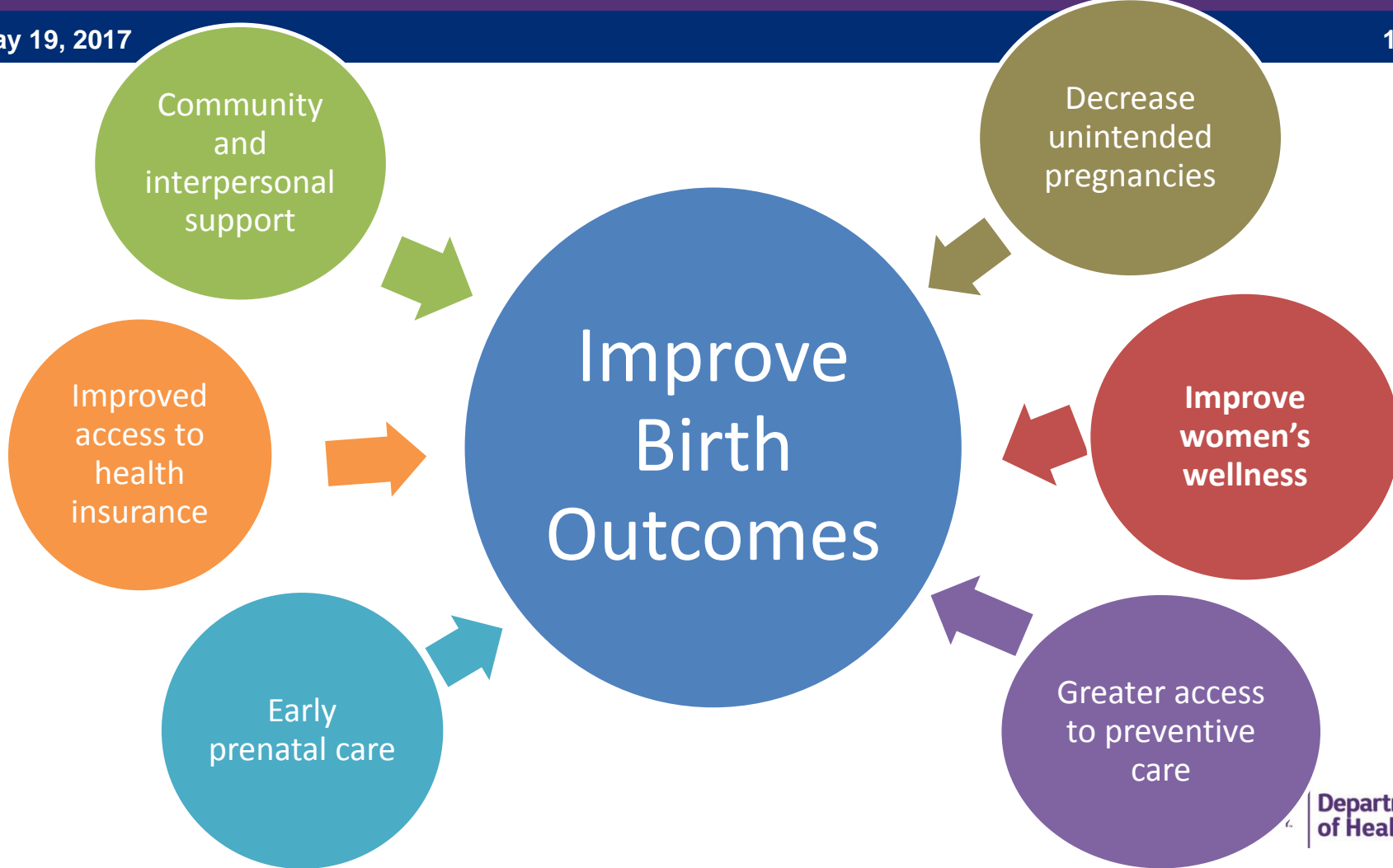
# Improve birth outcomes

- Prevention Agenda
  - Focus Area 1: Maternal & Infant Health
    - reduce premature births
    - reduce rates of maternal deaths
- Title V MCHSBG:
  - SP1: Reduce maternal mortality & morbidity
  - SP5: Increase use of primary and preventive health care services across the life course
  - SP7: Promote supports and opportunities that foster healthy home and community environments

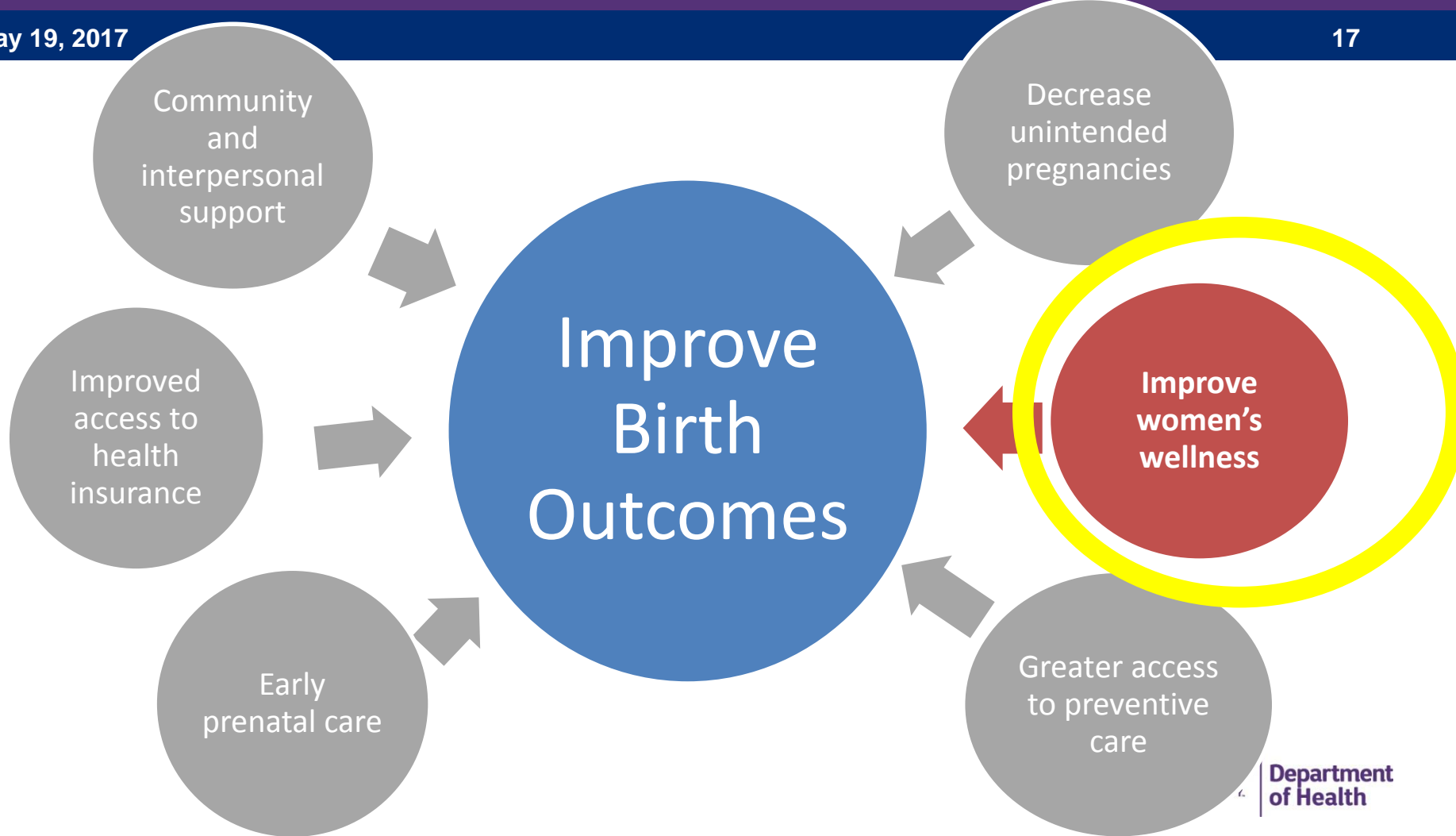


# Improve healthy relationships

- Prevention Agenda
  - Focus Area 1: Promote mental, emotional and behavioral (MEB) well-being in communities
- Title V:
  - SP3: Support and enhance children's social-emotional development and relationships
  - SP 4: Support and enhance adolescents' social-emotional development and relationships







# Improved Women's Wellness

## Family Planning

Clinical assessments/care

Reproductive Life Planning

Contraception & STI Care

Referrals provided for primary or specialty care as needed

## MCH Home Visiting

Outreach/identification of women not connected to care

Assessing client needs

Referrals and support needed to access care and services

Follow-up to ensure needs were met & referrals completed

## Adolescent Health

Evidence-based sexuality education

Support the social-emotional wellness of young people

Refer and provide support to adolescents seeking reproductive health services

Coordinated community-wide outreach and engagement of community members

Timely issuance and acceptance of referrals and feedback on referral status

Support large scale systems change to improve women's wellness
